Completed in 2010, the Natural Resources Building houses Tech's largest department, Petroleum Engineering. Built entirely from corporate donations, the NRB features state-of-the-art labs that allow students to work with industry standard and specialty equipment, including a Fracture Conductivity Measurement System, a Vertical Flow Loop, a Cement Slurry Property Testing Lab and Fracture Stimulation Equipment. In addition to this equipment, the NRB has two smart labs that allow world-renowned experts to give real-time presentations from anywhere in the world to Tech's students and faculty.
